**Please note, recycling is for Wheatfield Township residents only –
proof of residence will be required.**

Aluminum Cans

Rinsed and crushed. Foil is also accepted.

Bi-Metal (tin) Cans

Rinsed and crushed.

Glass

Rinsed (must be dry). All colors are accepted.

Office Grade Paper

Sheets or shredded.

Magazines/Newspapers/All Types of Books

Tied securely. May also be put in paper bags (No plastic bags). No staples.

Cardboard

Flattened cardboard, cereal and shipping boxes. No packing material.

Plastic Containers & Bottles

Rinsed and crushed, if possible.

*****Plastics do not need to be separated:**

#1 PETE All #1 containers including soda and small water bottles

#2 HDPE #2 natural, example: clear milk and gallon water bottles

#2 HDPE #2 colored such as detergent bottles and white or yellow milk bottles

** #5 & #7 are also accepted

Wheatfield Township Recycling Center is manned by volunteers. We encourage the residents to bring materials in a container in which they can reuse. Please do NOT have trash in with your recyclables. Thank you for your cooperation!
