

The regular meeting of the Wheatfield Township Supervisors was held Monday, July 3, 2017 in the Township Building. Barry Schrope called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Barry Schrope, Jim Fuller, Jeff Smith, Johanna Rehkamp, Lester Nace, Vicki Jenkins, Sue Flickinger, Paul Krieger, Kurt Hepschmidt and David Mills.

Barry Schrope led the pledge to the American flag followed by a brief moment of silence.

The minutes of the June 5, 2017 regular meeting were presented to the supervisors and posted for attendees in the Township Building prior to the July 3, 2017 regular meeting for public viewing. Jeff Smith made the motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting as presented by the secretary, Jim Fuller second the motion, Barry Schrope abstained (was not at June's meeting).

Paul Krieger asked Jeff Smith if they came out and looked at the stone that was in his yard from the pipe replacement. Jeff stated yes they were out there but it had already been cleaned up.

Kurt Hepschmidt asked if something could be done about the monument marker across from Joe Burget's on Montebello Farm Road. The supervisors stated they would go out and talk to the home owner.

David Mills thanked the township for continuing to support recreation in the township.

Jeff Smith presented the Road Master report for the month of June. Jeff stated the road crew has finished the first round of mowing, replaced 6 pipes on Cook Road, trimmed around the guard rails, hauled 4 loads of 2A stone, cleaned up debris from a heavy rain storm and replaced an inlet box on Karen Avenue and Hemlock Drive.

No representatives from the Duncannon Fire Co. were at tonight's meeting.

Barry Schrope advised the realtor contacted the Township and advised the seller of the land beside the township has declined our offer of \$50,000. The seller counter offered \$89,900.00. Jim Fuller made a motion to counter offer \$65,000 and the seller pays the closing costs, Barry Schrope second the motion, with all in favor.

Barry Schrope advised the Township has received the 2016 end of year financial report from the Duncannon EMS. The supervisors stated they will look over the report and wait till the sealcoat is applied to their parking lot before releasing the remaining portion of their donation. Barry also stated the township received correspondence from Kraig Nace regarding Duncannon EMS being accredited by the PA Emergency Health Services Council for the EMS for Children Voluntary Recognition Program. Barry stated they will have Kraig explain the accreditation at the next meeting.

Correspondence has been received from Kristie Smith at the Perry County Conservation District regarding the newly enacted Perry County Municipal Solid Waste Ordinance. The letter states each municipality is required to also enact a Municipal Solid Waste Collection Ordinance. The supervisors stated they will review the information.

Jeff Smith stated Martin Paving should be here next week to do the sealcoat. Jeff advised he has not heard anything yet from Wilson Paving for the paving project.

Lester Nace stated he had to shut down a contractor this week who was building without permits from the Township or BIU. Lester advised BIU was the one who contacted him about the problem.

Lester Nace asked how much weight was hauled out at our electronic recycling. Jeff Smith stated he believes it was over 20,000 lbs. Lester stated in the Carlisle Sentinel today it stated Carlisle is starting an e-cycling center and they will be charging \$.50/lb. to dispose of electronics and that it will be open to everyone.

Jim Fuller thanked the volunteers who came out and helped with recycling.

Barry Schrope made a motion to approve the checks from the General Fund for the month of June. They were as follows:

Jim Fuller second the motion to approve the checks, with all in favor.

There being no further business Jeff Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Barry Schrope second the motion, with all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
