

A budget workshop with the Supervisors was held Wednesday, September 27, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. in the Township Building. The workshop was advertised as required by law in the local paper. Those present were Barry Schrope, Jim Fuller, Jeff Smith, Vicki Jenkins, Kurt Hepschmidt and Sue Flickinger.

Kurt Hepschmidt stated his needs for Emergency Management are a portable radio with a cost of approximately \$2300 or above and a Hamm radio which would be a couple hundred dollars.

The supervisors went over the preliminary budget for 2018. There were several items discussed and will be further looked into.

Jeff Smith stated he would like to pave Cook Road (1.23 miles) and seal coat Sulphur Springs Road and Narrows Road this coming year.

Jeff Smith stated 6 pipes will need replaced on Basin Hill Road and 2 pipes on Linton Hill Road and also there are 2 pipes on Roseglen Road that need replaced.

Another budget workshop will be scheduled at the October meeting of the supervisors.

Workshop adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
