A budget workshop meeting with the Supervisors was held Thursday, November 21, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Township Building. The workshop was advertised as required by law in the local paper. Barry Schrope called the workshop to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Barry Schrope, Jim Fuller, Jeff Smith, Vicki Jenkins, Sue Flickinger and Lester Nace.

There was no public comment.

The supervisors looked over the 2020 preliminary budget from the October workshop and advised all looked good and that no changes were needed. The 2020 budget will be adopted at the December supervisors meeting.

The supervisors discussed the property for sale on Mountain Road with Lester Nace, Zoning Officer. The property is currently up for sale and has been used as a commercial property for approximately 50 years, but is zoned R2 on the township's zoning map. A business is interested in buying the property if it can still be used as commercial and a zoning variance application has been received. The supervisors will forward an email to the township solicitor with some questions they have before moving forward with the zoning variance.

The supervisors discussed the renovation of the old salt shed. Camp Hill Boro is selling a used 40 x 60 pole building and has sent a picture of it. The supervisors stated they would like to wait for an estimate from John Weldon before pursuing the pole building from Camp Hill.

Vicki Jenkins stated she had an inquiry about riding horses at Wagner Park in September. Vicki stated she gave permission to the resident but did not know that horses were not allowed at the park and posted on the rules at the gate. The supervisors stated they will talk with the recreation board for clarification.

Jeff Smith stated a meeting has been set up with Rob Shaffer to go over the drawings and bid package for the Wagner Park grant work. The meeting is Monday, November 25, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

Barry Schrope made a motion to adjourn the workshop, Jeff Smith second the motion, with all in favor. Workshop adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
