A budget workshop meeting with the Supervisors was held Thursday, November 18, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Building. The workshop was advertised as required by law in the local paper. Barry Schrope called the workshop to order at 7:00 p.m. Those present were Barry Schrope, Jim Fuller, Jeff Smith, Vicki Jenkins, Dexter Potter, Sue Flickinger, Elijah Barrick and Rhoda Barrick.

There was no public comment.

The supervisors looked over the 2022 preliminary budget from the October workshop. The only open item was the donation to the New Bloomfield EMS. The supervisors agreed to leave the donation where it currently stands and not increase their donation with them being out of service frequently; and advised all other items looked good and that no other changes were needed. The 2022 budget will be adopted at the December supervisors meeting.

Jeff Smith advised he would like to use the ARPA money to order extra pipe. All supervisors were in agreement.

Jeff Smith advised the Ford F250 failed inspection due to the bed rails being rusted out. Jeff stated he received 3 quotes to repair; \$1400 Perry Collision, \$1965 Maguires Ford and \$6423 Noakers. All supervisors were in agreement to have Perry Collision do the repair.

Jeff Smith stated he received 2 quotes for a tar buggy; 115 gallon \$13,000 and 260 gallon \$16,000. No decision was made on purchasing a tar buggy.

Jeff Smith asked about road sign replacement for Private Lanes in the Township. Road signs were required to comply with the 911 Emergency Center for easier location. Barry Schrope made a motion for the Township to replace the signs as needed, Jeff Smith second the motion, with all in favor.

The supervisors signed the Lester Weldon subdivision plan.

Jeff Smith made a motion to adjourn the workshop, Barry Schrope second the motion, with all in favor. Workshop adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
