The Wheatfield Township Parks and Recreation Board met on July 15, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT: John Weldon, Bob Foltz, Jeff Beinhower, Shawn Fuller, Jim Fuller and Dave Mills

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Dave Mills made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 17th meeting. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

Jeff Beinhower made a motion to pay the bills. Dave Mills seconded. Motion approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

(Carry Over) John Weldon presented a too do list as follows:

- Dig out area at bottom of bathroom steps
- Replace some 6"x6" beams around playground
- Need to build small bridge behind the pavilion above the stream
- Pressure wash restrooms, pavilion, picnic tables and small climbing toy
- Paint inside of restrooms, Paint the three red trashcans green

Discussion was held concerning the bridge project. Dave Mills will discuss the project with John Madden to determine the best approach for moving forward on the project. Dave Mills reported the John Madden did inform him that the required permits for the project are ready.

John Weldon reported that we need to finish filling the ruts on ball field #3.

John Weldon reported that brush needs to be trimmed on the outfield of ball field #1 and along the parking area at the pavilion.

John Weldon will talk to Jeff and Dexter about hauling and spreading stone on the railroad bed from the dimatex pit to the foot bridge.

Shawn Fuller will contact Tuscarora Hardwoods about the chipped wood for the playground.

Bob Foltz reported that the Duncannon Sportsmen's Association kid's trout derby was held at the park June 7th with 152 kids attending and everyone had a good time and they caught some fish. The Association appreciates the fact that they can use the park for the derby.

NEW BUSINESS:

John Weldon reported that he talked to Jeff and Dexter and they spread stone on the railroad bed from the dimatex pit to the foot bridge.

John Weldon reported that we need to get dog dropping bags. Bob Foltz will order the bags.

John Weldon reported that he, Jeff and Dave cut and moved trees that had fallen on the rail trail.

Dave Mills reported that he and John Weldon's grandson trimmed brush on the loop trail. Dave, Jeff, and John cleared the brush by the bridge. Paul Kreiger and his daughters helped clear brush on the trails.

Dave Mills reported he will get the bolts needed to repair one of the parts on the small climbing play toy.

Dave Mills reported that the banks along Narrows Road need Fertilized. Motion made by John Weldon to purchase four or five bags of fertilizer. Motion seconded by Dave Mills. Motion approved. John will get the needed fertilizer.

Shawn Fuller reported that Tuscarora Hardwoods agreed to donate 12 cubic yards of chipped wood for the playground if we will purchase 12 cubic yards. Motion was made by John to purchase the chips. Motion seconded by Dave Mills. Motion approved. John Weldon will contact Jeff and Dexter to have them deliver the chips to the playground.

Bob Foltz reported that Shawn Fuller, Shawn Fuller Jr. and Dave Mills trimmed the brush on the outfield of field #1 and along the parking area at the pavilion.

Jeff Beinhower agreed to contact Halterman Landscaping to get five scoops of topsoil to fill ruts on field #3. Motion made by John Weldon to have Jeff purchase the topsoil. Motion seconded by Bob Foltz. Motion approved. Jeff Beinhower will contact Haltermans and get Jeff and Dexter to pickup the soil.

Jeff Beinhower reported that Midget Football will practice Monday thru Thursday during August and Tuesday thru Thursday after school starts. Games are scheduled for 8/30, 9/6, 9/27 and 10/18.

John Weldon stated that the recreation board needs a chain saw to maintain the trails. John made a motion to purchase a 16" Stihl chain saw with two extra chains at an estimated price of \$350. Motion seconded by Jim Fuller. Motion approved. Jeff Beinhower will order the saw at Drive Core where we get a discount.

Motion was made by Bob Foltz to cancel the August meeting of the recreation because Bob and Shawn will have commitments at the Perry County Fair and Jeff may be out of town due to his job. Motion seconded by John Weldon. Bob will contact Vicki and ask her to put the required notice in the newspaper.

The next meeting will be October 21st, 2014 at the EMS building.

John Weldon made a motion to adjourn at 7:30. Jim Fuller seconded. Motion approved.
