

WHEATFIELD TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION

The Wheatfield Township Parks and Recreation Board met on May 17, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT: Bob Foltz, Dave Mills, John Weldon, Jeff Beinhower, Shawn Fuller, Jim Fuller, Dave Linville.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Dave Mills made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 19th meeting. Shawn Fuller seconded. Motion approved.

Shawn Fuller made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. Dave Mills seconded. Motion approved.

Shawn Fuller made a motion to pay the bills. Dave Mills seconded. Motion approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

(Carry Over) John Weldon presented the following list of things to do in 2015.

2. Need to build small bridge behind the pavilion above the stream (**Boy Scout Project**)
3. Paint the three trashcans green
4. Clear and fill area for a second pavilion
5. Trim Brush on the hiking trails. (Dave)
6. Re-Blaze the trail markers and property boundaries. (Dave)
8. Repair the steps at the end of the bridge (**Boy Scout Project**)
9. Repair area where sand is washing out on ball field #3.
11. Cut ground level down from large dumpster to bridge (left side of railroad).
12. Build new bridge.
13. Purchase top soil to fill in the area around the pavilion and playground.
14. Finish filling ruts on field #3.
15. Purchase and install new playground equipment (this means expanding the playground area)
16. Get more volunteers to help with projects and work details on Wednesday evenings.

Bob Foltz reported that he contacted Sylvester's Services on April 4, 2016, they will start picking up the trash every two weeks.

Bob Foltz reported he will get toilet paper, paper towels, and trash bags at the Gross-ery. He will also order dog waste bags from Bow Wow Waste.

Dave Mills reported he can get cans of tree marking paint from Grainger's at an estimated cost for \$12 per can. Bob Foltz made a motion to have Vicki Jenkins (township secretary) order the 6 cans thru the township account at Grainger's. Motion seconded by Dave Mills. Motion approved. Dave will contact Vicki to order the paint.

Dave Mills reported that John Weldon turned the water on. Also, the bases for the posts for the second pavilion have been laid out at the Wednesday evening meetings. The papers for Tom Jenkins (scout project to replace steps at end of bridge) have been signed.

Dave Mills reported that the fence was installed on the pitching backstop and it is complete. Also, Duncannon Girls Softball has started working on installing the posts for the batting cage between fields #2 and #3.

Dave Mills reported 12-15 tires were dumped over the bank on Narrows Road and they will be cleaned up to be taken to township spring cleanup which is April 21, 22 and 23.

NEW BUSINESS:

Dave Mills reported the bleacher at field #1 will be replaced with a lower 3 tier bleacher.

Dave Mills reported the chains on the tire swing need replaced. John Weldon stated he would get new chains.

Dave Mills reported Tom Jenkins Boy Scout project to replace the steps and build a small bridge at the north end of the bridge was approved by the Boy Scout Council and he will start 7/9/16. Dave has not heard anything from Joey Hestor concerning his Boy Scout Project to build a handicap fishing platform.

John Weldon reported that the bases for the spring toys were fixed, the concrete pad for the bleacher at field #1 was poured and the footers for the posts at pavilion #2 were poured.

John Weldon reported we can get the township summer hire to paint the trash cans and the three tier bleacher a field #1. John will contact the township employees to have the trees taken down at the site for pavilion #2 and we need two scoops of tanbark for around the trees.

Bob Foltz reported he will pay for two scoops of tanbark at New Blooms and the township employees can pick it up for the park.

Bob Foltz reported the six cans of tree marking paint were received and they cost \$32.52

Shawn Fuller reported he will contact Tuscarora Hardwoods to get 20 yards of chipped wood for the playground and see if Tuscarora will donate half to the park.

The next meeting will be June 21, 2016 at the park

Jim Fuller made a motion to adjourn at 7:30. Shawn Fuller seconded. Motion approved.
