The Wheatfield Township Parks and Recreation Board met on August 16, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT: Bob Foltz, Dave Mills, John Weldon, Shawn Fuller, Jeff Beinhower and Jim Fuller.

SECRETARY’S REPORT:

Shawn Fuller made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 19th meeting. Dave Mills seconded. Motion approved.

Jeff Beinhower made a motion to pay the bills. Jim Fuller seconded. Motion approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

(Carry Over) John Weldon presented the following list of things to do in 2015.

5. Trim Brush on the hiking trails. (Dave)
6. Re-Blaze the trail markers and property boundaries. (Dave)
9. Repair area where sand is washing out on ball field #3.
11. Cut ground level down from large dumpster to bridge (left side of railroad).
12. Build new bridge.
13. Purchase top soil to fill in the area around the pavilion and playground.
14. Finish filling ruts on field #3.
15. Purchase and install new playground equipment (this means expanding the playground area)
16. Gct more volunteers to help with projects and work details on Wednesday evenings.

Bob Foltz reported that he will purchase weed spray, an orange safety triangle for the gator and order a charcoal grill for the second pavilion. The roof trusses are on the second pavilion.

Shawn Fuller reported that Tuscarora Hardwoods agreed to donate 10 cubic yards of chipped wood for the playground and the recreation board will purchase 10 cubic yards. The township employees will pick up and deliver the chipped wood to the park.

John Weldon reported that he sprayed the grass growing on all the ball fields. Also, reinforcement pipe needs to be installed at the bottom of the fence on field #2 first and third baselines. He also expects to receive plans from Act One soon, for the bridge replacement project.

John Weldon reported he marked all the aluminum containers “Aluminum Cans Only”. And, he was stung by bees at the container at field #3.

Dave Mills reported that the sandbox needs tilled to remove the grass. Bob Foltz stated he will remove the grass with his tiller.

Dave Mills reported that Joey Hestor completed his boy scout project to install a handicap platform for fishing, also Tom Jenkins installed the steps at the end of the bridge and placed a small bridge across the wet area and he will put a handrail on the small bridge. We thank the boy scouts for the projects they do at the park.

Shawn Fuller reported that the township got the beams from the old Sulfur Springs bridge and he delivered them to the park for storage and future use.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bob Foltz reported that he purchased weed spray and an orange safety triangle for the Gator. The triangle is installed on the rear of the gator.

Bob Foltz reported that he and his grandsons tilled the sandbox and removed the grass.

The chipped wood for the playground was delivered by the township employees. The chipped wood was spread on August 3rd. The total cost for 20 cubic yards (10 purchased and 10 donated by Tuscarora) was \$140.

John Weldon reported he received the design plans for the bridge, from Act One. The recreation board has some questions about the plans and John will contact Act One.

John Weldon made a motion to pay Shawn Fuller \$200 for delivering the beams from the old Sulfur Springs Bridge. Motion seconded by Dave Mills. Motion approved.

John Weldon stated the recreation board needs to create rules for use of the pavilions and have them posted at the pavilions. Also, the metal roof is installed on pavilion #2

Dave Mills reported that Tom Jenkins (boy scout project) placed a handrail on the small bridge he placed over the wet area on the loop trail.

Dave Mills stated that the recreation board needs to have a sign made to recognize the boy scouts who have done projects at the park.

The next meeting will be September 20, 2016 at the park

Jim Fuller made a motion to adjourn at 7:30. Shawn Fuller seconded. Motion approved.
