The Wheatfield Township Parks and Recreation Board met on September 20, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT: Bob Foltz, Dave Mills, John Weldon, Shawn Fuller Dave Linville.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Dave Mills made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 16th meeting. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

Dave Mills made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

Dave Mills made a motion to pay the bills. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

(Carry Over) John Weldon presented the following list of things to do in 2015.

5. Trim Brush on the hiking trails. (Dave)
6. Re-Blaze the trail markers and property boundaries. (Dave)
9. Repair area where sand is washing out on ball field #3.
11. Cut ground level down from large dumpster to bridge (left side of railroad).
12. Build new bridge.
13. Purchase top soil to fill in the area around the pavilion and playground.
14. Finish filling ruts on field #3.
15. Purchase and install new playground equipment (this means expanding the playground area)
16. Get more volunteers to help with projects and work details on Wednesday evenings.

Bob Foltz reported that he purchased weed spray and an orange safety triangle for the Gator. The triangle is installed on the rear of the gator.

Bob Foltz reported that he and his grandsons tilled the sandbox and removed the grass.

The chipped wood for the playground was delivered by the township employees. The chipped wood was spread on August 3rd. The total cost for 20 cubic yards (10 purchased and 10 donated by Tuscarora) was \$140.

John Weldon reported he received the design plans for the bridge, from Act One. The recreation board has some questions about the plans and John will contact Act One.

John Weldon made a motion to pay Shawn Fuller \$200 for delivering the beams from the old Sulfur Springs Bridge. Motion seconded by Dave Mills. Motion approved.

John Weldon stated the recreation board needs to create rules for use of the pavilions and have them posted at the pavilions. Also, the metal roof is installed on pavilion #2

Dave Mills reported that Tom Jenkins (Boy Scout project) will place a handrail on the small bridge he placed over the wet area on the loop trail.

Dave Mills stated that the recreation board needs to have a sign made to recognize the boy scouts who have done projects at the park.

NEW BUSINESS:

Dave Mills reported that Joey Hestor completed the handicap platform and the cracker dust path to the platform is done. Dave signed off on Joey's Boy Scout project forms.

Dave reported that Joey Hestor needs some funds to pay for 4x4s used to line the pathway to the handicap platform. Dave made a motion for the recreation board to donate up to \$150 if Joey can't get the funds from another organization. Motion seconded by John Weldon. Motion approved.

Dave Mills is writing an article for the fall township newsletter.

John Weldon reported that Ron Baker contacted him and the Duncannon Girls Softball Association would like permission to put a 10x14 foot storage shed on the railroad bed. Dave Mills made a motion to allow girls softball to install a storage shed on the railroad bed. Motion seconded by John Weldon. Motion approved. John Weldon will contact Jeff Smith to have the ground graded where the shed will be placed.

The next meeting will be October 18, 2016 at the township building.

Jim Fuller made a motion to adjourn at 7:30. Shawn Fuller seconded. Motion approved.
