The Wheatfield Township Parks and Recreation Board met on August 20, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT: Dave Mills, John Weldon, Shawn Fuller, Bob Foltz, Jim Fuller, guests Dave Linville and Phyllis Kreiger.

SECRETARY’S REPORT:

Shawn Fuller made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 16th, 2019 meeting. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

Shawn Fuller made a motion to pay the bills. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

(Carry Over) John Weldon presented the following list of things to do in 2015.

5. Trim Brush on the hiking trails. (Dave)
6. Re-Blaze the trail markers and property boundaries. (Dave)
9. Repair area where sand is washing out on ball field #3.
11. Cut ground level down from large dumpster to bridge (left side of railroad).
12. Build new bridge.
13. Purchase top soil to fill in the area around the pavilion and playground.
14. Finish filling ruts on field #3.
15. Purchase and install new playground equipment (this means expanding the playground area)
16. Get more volunteers to help with projects and work details on Wednesday evenings.

Discussion was held and following list of projects was developed for the township employees and summer hire.

1. Clear trails and mark trees on trails.
2. Clear a trail from the loop trail down to the west end of the Paradise Road Bridge.
4. Pressure wash tractor, gator, mower, inside of restrooms.
10. Grade area on field #1 outfield so water can run to the creek.
11. Place and grade shale to fill in around pavilion #2.

Bob Foltz reported he paid New Blooms for two scoops of tanbark. The township employees got the tanbark and spread it around the trees at the park.

Bob Foltz reported that Dave Linville drained the water from the field rollers.

Dave Mills reported he sprayed yellow jackets by the bridge.

John Weldon reported that he used the leaf blower to clear the floors at both pavilions. He will talk to Jeff Smith and ask him to have the summer hires use the blower when they mow the grass or whenever it is needed.

John Weldon reported that he made a list of to do things at the park and will give it to Jeff Smith so the summer hire employees can work to the items.

John Weldon reported that he and Dave Mills and Dave Linville filled and seeded ruts on field #3.

NEW BUSINESS:

Phyllis Krieger attended the meeting to get more information to apply for funds/grant money to purchase two items to expand the playground area.

Dave Mills reported that a bid package will need to be prepared for the paving work for pavilion #2, road to the bridge and construction of the bridge. Dave will check with Jeff Smith to get the status.

Dave Mills reported that the bleachers were placed at the football field and the players benches were put in place.

Dave Mills reported that Landon Finger is working on getting donations to fund his Eagle Scout project to build a Gaga Ball Pit between Pavilions #1 and #2.

Dave Mills reported that the park needs some new metal trash cans. The bottoms have rusted out of some of the cans. Shawn Fuller stated he will be going up routes 11/15 and he can get new cans and they should be about \$10 each. Bob Foltz made a motion to have Shawn get four new trash cans. Motion seconded by John Weldon. Motion approved.

John Weldon reported that he cleaned up broken bottles at the pavilion and in the parking lot. He also found that someone had wrapped the swing chains around the posts. The usual people who do not care about the park!

John Weldon reported that Carlton Williams painted the roof on Pavilion #2, it looks good. Bob Foltz will pay Carlton for the paint as soon as he gives him a bill.

Bob Foltz reported he will get supplies, such as toilet paper, trash can bags and hand sanitizer.

The next meeting will be September 17th, 2019 at the park.

Shawn Fuller made a motion to adjourn at 7:30. John Weldon seconded. Motion approved.
