(Carry Over) John Weldon presented the following list of things to do in 2015.

Dave Mills reported that a bid package will need to be prepared for the paving work for pavilion #2, road to the bridge and construction of the bridge. Dave will check with Jeff Smith to get the status.

Dave Mills reported that the bleachers were placed at the football field and the players benches were put in place.

Dave Mills reported that Landon Finger is working on getting donations to fund his Eagle Scout project to build a Gaga Ball Pit between Pavilions #1 and #2.

Dave Mills reported that the park needs some new metal trash cans. The bottoms have rusted out of some of the cans. Shawn Fuller stated he will be going up routes 11/15 and he can get new cans and they should be about \$10 each. Bob Foltz made a motion to have Shawn get four new trash cans. Motion seconded by John Weldon. Motion approved.

John Weldon reported that he cleaned up broken bottles at the pavilion and in the parking lot. He also found that someone had wrapped the swing chains around the posts. The usual people who do not care about the park!

John Weldon reported that Carlton Williams painted the roof on Pavilion #2, it looks good. Bob Foltz will pay Carlton for the paint as soon as he gives him a bill.

Bob Foltz reported he will get supplies, such as toilet paper, trash can bags and hand sanitizer.

John Weldon reported the signs for the Pine Tree Trail are installed.

John Weldon reported the plumbing for the urinal in the men's restroom needs replaced.

John Weldon made and mounted a box to hold trash bags at pavilion #2.

Shawn Fuller presented a bill for the four trash cans he picked up for the park. Bob Foltz made a motion to pay Shawn \$36 for the trash cans. Dave Mills seconded the motion. Motion approved. Bob thanked Shawn for getting the cans and paid him.

Dave Mills reported he has not heard anything from Landon Finger on the status of his boy scout project to build a Gaga Ball pit.

Dave Mills reported there will be a township budget workshop 9/25, at 9 am if anyone would wish to attend.

Act One should be working with Jeff Smith to develop a bid package for the paving/bridge project. John will contact Jeff to get an update.
