Discussion:

The evenings discussion began with the Hetrick/Frank subdivision plan. Chris Hinkle(Burget & Associates) presented the plan. He began with the "Plan Purpose" which is to subdivide an existing 36 acre tract into

2 separate tracts. The proposed lot #2 is to be a non-building recreational lot.

All county, engineering, and zoning officer comments were then discussed and reviewed with no outstanding issues.

The WTPC made a recommendation to add a note to the plan that the accessory building on Lot #1, which has its own well, can not be used as a residence.

Chris stated he will add this to the plan.

One AOR was requested. This was for "Final Review" of the proposed plan.

Dave J. made a motion to grant the AOR, David Mills 2nd, all were in favor.

Next a motion was made to "Approve" the plan pending the additional note regarding the accessory building on Lot #1.

Dave J. made a motion to approve the proposed plan, Paul 2nd, all were in favor.

This plan will now go to the BOS with a recommendation of "Approval" from the WTPC.

Other Action:

The WTPC reviewed the current rules and regulations pertaining to solar panels in the Twp. This seemed to only cover small residential solar panels and not large scale solar farms. This will be looked into with input from the BOS in future meetings.
